Paying Your Bill

VOA-MN Mental Health Clinics' has a variety of ways you can pay your bill.

In Office- individuals may pay copays or balances due at the front desk of our Anoka or Golden Valley locations. We accept cash, check, or credit cards.

Recurring payments- if you would like to have payments deducted monthly from your credit/debit card, please contact our Billing Office at 952-945-4057 to have this set up.

Insurance Coverage

An individual's health insurance is billed for outpatient services. Individuals covered by insurance should bring their current insurance cards to each visit. Based on the insurance policy, clients may have financial responsibility for copays, deductibles, or co-insurance.

Copays

Copays are due at the time of each visit.

Adjusted Fees

We offer adjusted payment plans for those clients/ families who are unable to pay their bill in full. Sliding fee amounts are based on income and family size. Grants and Contracts
