## ROGER MEYER NAMED VOA MN/WI INTERIM PRESIDENT AND CEO



**Minneapolis – Sept. 16, 2019** – Volunteers of America Minnesota/Wisconsin (VOA MN/WI) announced today that their Board of Directors has selected Roger Meyer to serve as Interim President and CEO until a long-term President and CEO is named. Roger has worked with a variety of non-profits, partnerships, government entities and community groups as they go through leadership transitions.

VOA MN/WI is one of the area’s largest health and human services organizations. It recently completed a five-year Strategic Plan for the years 2020-2024 with a focus on becoming a national model of excellence in health and human services as well as continuing to be a strong, stable and innovative nonprofit organization.

Roger has strong ties to VOA. He previously served as the Interim President & CEO before Paula Hart was selected to lead the organization eight years ago. His father also once served on the VOA Board of Directors.

Roger’s first day coincides with Paula’s last day: Tuesday, October 1. VOA MN/WI will be working with Ballinger Leafblad Inc. to conduct a national search for a long-term President and CEO.
