THE STATISTICS

- ▶ The latest Centers for Disease Control research says by 2060 Alzheimer's disease and related dementias (ADRD) will increase some 178% among all Americans (65 years and older), but African American, Hispanic, and other racial and ethnic groups will see the fastest growing rates. bit.ly/2NxcCe0
- ▶ Statistics are showing that by 2030, African Americans and Latinos will make up nearly 40% of the 8.4 million American families affected by Alzheimer's disease.

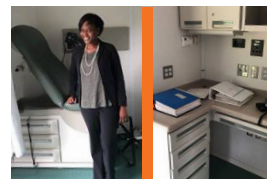
COMMITTED STAFF
