School Based Therapist

VOA has a fully licensed therapist who can meet with students at school, during the school day. Meeting with the therapist offers students a safe space where a trained professional can help improve their ability to face problems, build self-esteem and increase their overall sense of well-being. Students with or without insurance can see the therapist and have access to services that can otherwise be difficult to access.

School Social Worker

The Social Worker at VOAHS works with students and their families to ensure that they have access to what they need to be successful inside and outside of the classroom.

They help provide resources for food, housing, medical aid, and much more.

ALC+ Coordinator

The "Plus" Coordinator works closely with 20 VOA students who have Hennepin County involvement. The ALC+ Coordinator works with students to provide individualized support to help these students reach academic, engagement and personal goals.
