

Pathways specializes in providing residential Substance Use Disorder (SUD) and mental health treatment services to adolescent males ages 12-17. Programming utilizes SMART Recovery and Dialectical Behavioral Therapy and offers trauma-responsive care through an integrative systems-based model.

Youth accepted to the Dual Service Track may present with serious mental health and substance use issues and have a history of unsuccessful treatment attempts in the community and/or other residential programs. The primary goal for youth on the Dual Service Track is to identify and overcome barriers to sobriety, work closely with family to build a supportive recovery environment, and learn to effectively manage their mental health.
